

FORUM THEATRE


The ACTion for Inclusion program is based in the Forum Theatre methodology.

Forum Theatre is an UNESCO-recognized tool for learning where participants watch a scenario showcasing a social issue.



Then, they are invited by an experienced facilitator to comment on the action, suggest changes to the story, and try out their own strategies to result in a positive alternative ending.

STAFF LEARNING JOURNEY



In consultation with your team, we create an interactive presentation that incorporates the workplace issues you want to address.

Our actors perform in negative and problematic scenarios that depict how the issue plays out in real workplaces.

Our experienced facilitator invites your staff to roleplay potential strategies to address the challenges.

Our facilitator engages your staff in a **debrief of the strategies shared** so staff can create an action plan to foster an inclusive environment.

PRESENTATION TOPICS

Key Learning

Topic - Uncertainty & Anxiety

Key Learning

- Discuss how health concerns and uncertainty can exacerbate anxiety
- Learn how to recognize the signs that a colleague is in need of support
- Practice ways to be supportive mental health allies to co-workers

BOOKING PROCESS


1) Reach out to our MCT team to set up an initial booking conversation to discuss possibilities.
